This Program provides monetary rebates for completed turf replacement projects and is not responsible in any manner for any disputes you may have with your contractor with regard to the turf replacement project. Your contractor must also provide a signed bid, contract, or proposal to show an agreement to complete the project.

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Qualifications / Terms & Conditions

The Department of Water Resources' Residential Turf Rebate Program and the Electric & Gas Industries Association (EGIA) disclaim any and all responsibility, liability, loss or damage, and make no guarantees related to:

- Participation in the Contractor Direct Rebate Option and any dispute that may arise between you and your contractor;
- Loss or delay of rebate check in the mail;
- Any taxes that may be imposed as a result of participation in the Contractor Direct Rebate Option; and
- Contractor adherence to the terms and conditions needed to receive this rebate.

Customers are eligible to participate in the Save Our Water Turf Rebate Program if you are:

- Not in an area where a turf replacement rebate is being offered for \$2 or more per square foot. AND;
- Converting an area that has existing turf. Bare earth areas with no sign of turf are not eligible, and;
- Have not previously received a rebate from the Save Our Water Turf Rebate Program or other water agencies for the same project equal to or in excess of the maximum allowed turf replacement rebate amount.

Property Managers are eligible to participate in the Save Our Water Turf Rebate Program if:

- The property owner meets the eligibility requirements for the Save Our Water Turf Rebate Program AND;
- You are acting on behalf of the account holder and can provide sufficient documentation to ensure that your firm has a current agreement with the property owner and/or account holder.

If you are a tenant where this service is completed you are responsible for obtaining the property owner's permission to complete the turf replacement project for which you are applying for a rebate. Your signature on this Contractor Direct Rebate Option Customer Release Form indicates that you have obtained this permission. Should it be deemed necessary, the Department of Water Resources retains the right to require written proof of the property manager's permission to convert the landscape per the program requirements.

All yard conversions are subject to verification/inspection by the Program Administrator to ensure that the project has been acceptably completed. Tenants must allow, if requested, the Save Our Water Turf Rebate Program or a program representative reasonable access to their home to verify satisfactory project completion.

Please Note: The Water Service Account Holder may be contacted to verify any of the information provided in this form prior to payment of a rebate check to the installing contractor. **This form makes no guarantee that the rebate will be approved and a check issued.**
